Mabel Doane memorial held

Mabel D. Doane, 84, of Kellogg died early Tuesday, March 25, at Marshalltown Medical Center.

The body was cremated immediately. A memorial service was scheduled for 2 p.m. Thursday at the Kellogg Christian Church, preceded by a private family interment of ashes at Our Silent City Cemetery in Kellogg.
