

John Doonan, 86, Dies At Brooklyn; Services Monday

Funeral rites for John Doonan, 86, Brooklyn, were held Monday at the Bramer Funeral Home in Brooklyn. Mr. Doonan died March 12th at a nursing home in Tama.
