

# Lacy Doty buried at Deep River <sup>Monte</sup> <sub>Exp.</sub>

Funeral rites for Lacy V. Doty of rural Deep River were conducted by the Rev. Eugene Stohs Thursday afternoon, Dec. 27, at the Calvary Lutheran Church. Music was provided by Mrs. Lanny Wilcox and the congregation. Flower attendants were Mrs.

Mr. Doty, 82, died Monday, Dec. 24, of leukemia at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Iowa City.

The son of James and Ida Spoon Doty, he was born Feb. 24, 1897, at Huston, Mo. He served in the Army from September 1918 until March 1919 during World War I. On Feb. 7, 1923, he was married to Emma Timm at St. John's Lutheran Church in Lincoln Township. They established a farm home in Iowa County and have lived near Deep River since March 1934. He was a member of Calvary Lutheran Church and the American Legion.

He is survived by his wife, Emma; three children, Mrs. Willard (Maxine) Bortz of Cedar Rapids, Mrs. Don (Marian) Schuldt of Montezuma, LaVerne Doty of Deep River; and two brothers, Frank Doty of Ladora and Carley Doty of Belleville, Ill.

He was preceded in death by a daughter, Bernice, his parents, two brothers and three sisters.
