

Rites held for Mr. Doughman

James Doughman, 79, of St. Francis Manor died Wednesday, May 4, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted at 9 a.m. Saturday at St. Mary's Catholic Church, with the Rev. Anthony Farrell officiating.
