James J. Doyle, 68, of Grinnell died of cancer Monday, June 3, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

Graveside services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Friday at Hazelwood Cemetery with the Rev. Daniel I. Ogata, pastor of the Malcom Presbyterian Church, officiating.
