Mrs. Harriett Dunham Dies Here Saturday

Funeral Services Today
For Granddaughter
Of Grinnell's Founder

Mrs. Harriett Dunham, 82, Grinnell, passed away at a local hospital early Saturday morning. She had been hospitalized for a month.

Funeral services for Mrs. Harriett Dunham were held at 2:00 p.m. Monday at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Leland W. Mann, minister of the Congregational church officiating. Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery.

Pallbearers were Bob Maring, Worth Belden, Homer McDonough, Elmer Iverson, Ellis Brown and Burdette Abel. Organist was Mrs. Kathleen Heffner.

Mrs. Dunham was born January 21, 1878, in Grinnell, the daughter of Levi Parsons and Harriett Knight Grinnell, and graduated from Grinnell high school. On June 7, 1907, in Grinnell, she was united in marriage with Egbert Harold Dunham by the Rev. L. F. Parker.

To this union were born three children: John Russell Dunham, deceased; Harold Grinnell Dunham and Miss Marian Duham both of Grinnell. She also leaves five grandchildren.

Mrs. Dunham was preceded in death by her husband, Egbert Harold Dunham in 1957; her son John in 1944; and her brother, Josiah B. Grinnell in 1952.

Mrs. Dunham was a lifelong resident of Grinnell, and was a member of the Congregational church and the Women's Society of the church.
