Glen M. Dunwoody, 80, of New Sharon died Saturday, Dec. 30, at the New Sharon Care Center.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday at the Harden Funeral Home in New Sharon, with the Rev. Cornie Van Wyngarden officiating. Burial was in Friends Cemetery, New Sharon.

He was the son of Marion "Jake" and Mary Van Hoever Dunwoody and was born Aug. 10, 1915, in Peoria, Iowa. He was married to Jeanetta Zwank Oct. 29, 1943. She died in September 1981.

Mr. Dunwoody was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II, serving in the Philippines. Following the war he was a mechanic at the Ford garage in New Sharon, then worked for the New Sharon and North Mahaska school districts as a bus mechanic and driver for 28 years. He retired in 1980.
