Rites held for Gus Ebert

Gus A. Ebert, 89, of Kellogg died Thursday, Jan. 31, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were conducted at 10:30 a.m. Monday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kellogg, with the Rev. Alfred Schultz officiating. Burial was in Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg.

He was the son of Frederick and Caroline Ebert and was born on June 22, 1895, in Jasper County. He was a veteran of World War I and had farmed in Marshall and Jasper counties until retiring in 1962.
