Harry H. Eisele 1896

Harry H. Eisele was born March 21, 1896, in Malcom Township, Poweshiek County, the son of Charles and Frances Eisele. He passed away Wednesday morning, May 27, 1953 at his home near Grinnell at the age of 57 years 2 months and 6 days. As an infant he was baptized in the Lutheran faith.
