Mr. Emmert rites Tuesday

Everett V. Emmert, 82, of 134 East St., Grinnell, died Saturday, May 31, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services will be con-

ducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Keith Briggs, pastor of the Grinnell First Friends Church, officiating. Burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery.
