

William English, 90, Native Of County, Dies In Oregon

William Terrill English, 90, a resident of Salem, Ore., the past 50 years, but a native of Poweshiek county, died Friday in a Salem hospital after an illness of the past several weeks. He had been in failing health the last few years.

Funeral services were held in Salem and graveside services are to be held Friday, Aug. 5th, at the Stewart cemetery northwest of New Sharon with the Smith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. Masonic graveside rites will be conducted by the Lynnville Masonic lodge.

Mr. English was the son of John and Mary Ellen Stanley English and was born on a farm near Searsboro. He attended the local rural schools near his home.

In early manhood he was united in marriage with Elizabeth J. Myers. They farmed for several years and then moved to Salem where Mr. English worked in a lumber mill.

Mrs. English died in 1923. Later he was married to Mrs. Delia Riggs of Salem, Ore., who survives.
