

## Services for Mr. Evans

Lyman T. Evans, 80, Fairfield, formerly of Grinnell, died Tuesday, July 5, in the Jefferson County Hospital in Fairfield.

Funeral services were held Thursday morning in the First Presbyterian Church in Fairfield with burial in Evergreen Cemetery in Fairfield. Savings and Loan and also on the board of the First National Bank of Fairfield, was a director of the United Fire and Casualty Co. of Cedar Rapids and a trustee of the Shining Trail Council of the Girl Scouts of America.

He was preceded in death by his wife and two brothers. He is survived by one daughter Susan Kate Phipps, one son James Evans and four grandchildren, all of Fairfield; four sisters Florence Tew and Louise Agnew of Grinnell, Irene Walker, California and Mary Grey, Des Moines, who died Tuesday evening.
