~~Euphemia~~ Burns (Ewart) was born
in Morrow county, Ohio, March 23,
1835 and died at her home at Ewart
on Dec. 25, 1906. She was married on
May 20, 1861 to Robert Ewart who
preceded her in death on Sept. 9, 1905.
To them were born three sons and
three daughters of whom five are
living, the youngest daughter having
passed away April 28, 1902.

Mr. and Mrs. Ewart moved to Iowa
in 1863, settling in this county where
she has ever since resided. Having
united with the Baptist church in
Ohio when 18 years of age, she held
her interest in religious things and
there being no church of her denomi-
nation at Ewart she was admitted to
the Christian church there on letter
and has since remained a faithful and
consistent member of this church.

Funeral services were conducted
Monday afternoon at one o'clock by
the Rev. J. Arthur Hurley of Grinnell
at the Methodist church at Ewart
and the remains taken to Mt. Gilead,
Ohio for interment. The remains
were accompanied there by the three
loving sons of the deceased.
