S. B. Faircloth. 1913

S. B. Faircloth was born at Yadkinsville, Sarey County, N. C., Oct. 30th, 1834, and died at his daughter's home in Grinnell, October 26th, 1913. He came to Iowa when a young man and settled with his parents near Montezuma, afterwards moving to Washington township in the same county. In 1864 he was united in marriage to Miss Katherine Prosser and to this union were born eleven children, eight of whom are now living. He also leaves four brothers. He was ill for about five months before the end came and was always patient under his sufferings. The cause of his death was heart trouble. He was buried in the Westfield cemetery, near where he had lived so long, last Tuesday, Rev. W. R. Lawrence officiating. Mr. Faircloth was a member of the Methodist church.
