**Paul Farrell Funeral
Was Saturday, April 3,
In Barnes City**

Funeral services for Paul Farrell were held at the Barnes City Methodist Church Saturday afternoon, April 3, with Rev. Wm. Morehouse officiating. Leslie Steele sang several selections accompanied by organist, Mrs. William Landstrum.

Interment was in Barnes City Cemetery. Serving as casketbearers were: Harold Lester, Gale Riggs, Donald Patterson, John Westercamp, Charles Hamilton and Lewis McKee.

Paul Werts Farrell, son of Dr. John and Flora Farrell, was born May 6, 1887, at Grinnell, and passed away in a Grinnell hospital April 1, 1965, at 77 years of age.

He spent his early childhood in Grinnell and the family later moved to Bedford, Iowa. In 1894, they moved to Barnes City, where he graduated from high school in 1905. In 1928 he received his Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Iowa.

On February 23, 1921, he married Clara Myers, of Waukeo, Iowa. Three children were born to this marriage.

Those surviving are: his wife; his daughter, Charlotte, and her husband, Bert Larzelere, of Toledo; a son, David and his wife, Lora, their son, Michael, of Dennison, Iowa; also, two nieces, Helen Burr, of Charlottesville, Va., and Linda Farrell, of Oakland, Calif.

Mr. Farrell spent 31 years in the teaching profession, retiring in 1956. He was a teacher and superintendent at Colfax, Farrar, Epworth, Delta and Barnes City.

He was a member of the Barnes City Methodist Church.
