Funeral services for Dorothy F. Fauver were held Saturday in Omaha. She was a Brooklyn native, and she and her husband, M. J. (Joe) Fauver had made their home in Omaha since 1958.

Mrs. Fauver was born Feb. 9, 1914 at Brooklyn, the daughter of Arthur and Lydia Rhinehart. She attended Brooklyn schools.

She married M. J. (Joe) Fauver, and they reared their children in Brooklyn, where the family operated the Opera House. Mrs. Fauver was also proprietor of a cafe in the Brooklyn Opera House.
