## Orrin Ferguson, Lifetime Resident Of Area Succumbs

Orrin W. Ferguson, 78, 703 Main St., died Sunday forenoon at a local hospital.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2 p.m. from the Trinity Lutheran church with the Rev. Fred Peters officiating. Organ music will be furnished by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner.

Serving on the flower committee will be Mr. and Mrs. Grant Heishman and Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Schultz. Pallbearers will be Veri Tharpe, Grover Loftin, Kenneth Gross, Grover Schultz, Ernest Badger and Kevin Griffin. Interment will be in Trinity Lutheran cemetery.

A lifelong resident of the Grinnell area, Mr. Ferguson was born on Nov. 1st, 1882, in Chester Township, the son of August and Eliza Cato Ferguson. He attended the schools of this area.

On Oct. 25th, 1905, he was united in marriage with Ida Puls at the home of her parents in Malcom. They made their home in the Malcom community, but for the last year Mr. Ferguson had lived in Grinnell with his daughter, Mrs. Grace Schultz.

He is survived by his daughter; a brother, Ray Ferguson of Vero Beach, Fla.; a sister, Mrs. Augusta Lynch of Houston, Tex.; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife in December of 1940; and a brother, Fred, and two sisters, Mrs. Ada Hyes and Mrs. Julin Miller, all of Houston, Tex.
