

Mrs. Figland Dies in Illinois

Mrs. Lenora Figland, 85, a former resident of Grinnell, died Thursday morning at Moline, Ill.

Mrs. Figland had been a resident of Grinnell until January of 1971, when she moved to Moline.

Dies in Moline

Mrs. Figland, 85 years old at the time of her death in a Moline, Ill., hospital on Sept. 2, had lived in Grinnell until January of this year, when she moved to Moline to be with her daughter, Mrs. Doris Brown.

She was born on July 18, 1886, in Artesian, S. D., the daughter of Louis and Sophia Carlson Tysdal. She received her early education in South Dakota, and later graduated from Jewell College. For a number of years she taught school in South Dakota.

She was married to Louis J. Figland on March 16, 1909, at Woonsocket, S. D. They first lived in that community, later moving to a farm southeast of Grinnell where they farmed until his death on July 19, 1950. In 1951 Mrs. Figland moved to Grinnell where she lived until going to Moline in January.

She is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Brown, Moline; one son, LeRoy, of Medina, Ohio; seven grandchildren, 13 great-grandchildren, and a sister, Mrs. George (Mae) Anderson of Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan, Canada. She was preceded in death by her husband, two daughters, Avis and Lois, her parents, four brothers and two sisters.
