

MS Lois Flint Buried At Deep River May 28

Funeral services for Miss Lois Flint were conducted by the Rev. Wesley Wilson, minister of the Free Methodist Church, Wednesday afternoon, May 28, at the Powers Funeral Home in Oskaloosa.
