Ruth E. Fowler, 84, of Tama died Thursday, July 26, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center where she was admitted Wednesday following a stroke.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at Hand's Funeral Chapel in Tama, with the Rev. Marvin Foss of Grinnell officiating. Burial was at Haven Cemetery, rural Tama.

She was the daughter of Edwin S. and Julia Elder Ben Hand and was born July 14, 1917, on the family farm south of Tama. She received her education at a school near her home.
