Mrs. E. W. Galt Died In Shenandoah On Sunday Night

Word reached Grinnell today that Mrs. E. W. Galt died Sunday night in Shenandoah, where she and Rev. Mr. Galt had gone last week to be with the wife of Rev. Mr. Galt's brother, who had just died. The wife is also very ill. Rev. and Mrs. Galt were in an auto accident last Thursday, presumably on their way from Grinnell to Shenandoah, and it is presumed that Mrs. Galt's death stems from that cause although details are not known here.

Rev. Royal J. Montgomery will go to Shenandoah to conduct funeral services on Wednesday. Burial will be in Tabor.

Rev. and Mrs. Galt had returned only a few months ago from China, where they had spent years in missionary work and had made a great many friends during their brief residence here.
