Funeral services were held at 2 o'clock this afternoon in the Congregational church for Mrs. Pearl Garner, who died at her home here Sunday afternoon. The services were in charge of the Rev. Robert Inglis. Pallbearers were H. C. Morse, S. E. Raffety, E. M. Kearney, John Evans, A. L. Burgett and James McKee. Interment will be made Wednesday in the cemetery at Ida Grove.

For many years Mrs. Garner, who would have been eighty years old on October 22, has been one of the outstanding women of this community, and her whole-hearted support of the Congregational church has left a distinct impress upon that church. Mrs. Garner had maintained an active interest in church and community life until two months ago when the illness from which she died confined her to her home.

She is survived by her husband, Pearl Garner; four sons, Dr. W. A. Garner of Kiron, Iowa; Ralph of Columbus, Ohio; Ed of Ida Grove; Dwight of California; a daughter, Mrs. Clyde Barrett of Lawton, Ia.; a sister, Mrs. Will Johnson of Ida Grove; and a brother, S. M. Cory, also of Ida Grove.
