George Gilligan Services Monday

A rosary service for George Gilligan, 45, president of Farmhand, Inc., was held at 8 p.m. Monday at the Strobeck-Johnson Mortuary in Hopkins, Minn.

Mr. Gilligan, who died of an apparent heart attack at his home in Edina, Minn., was buried yesterday (Tuesday) in Dubuque, Ia.

Mr. Gilligan became president and chief operations officer of Farmhand in March of 1967. Previously, he was a vice president for Bucyrus Erie Co. of South Milwaukee, Wis., for eight years and a chief industrial engineer for John Deere & Co., Moline, Ill. He was an engineering graduate of the University of Iowa.

He is survived by his widow Suzanne, his son George, and his daughter Susan, along with a brother and three sisters.
