Theodore Glasgow, 72, of 1009 Center St., Grinnell, died Wednesday, March 2, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at the Calvary Baptist Church, with the Rev. Bruce Feuerbach officiating. Organist was Nancy Sears, and vocalists were Leroy and Doris Calvin. A veterans service was conducted at Eaton Cemetery near Unionville.

The son of Henry and Verla Stevens Glasgow, he was born Feb. 6, 1922, near Udell. He attended rural school and later worked for area farmers. He served with the U.S. Army in Europe during World War II.

On March 15, 1947, he was married to Pearl McCrory in Bloomfield. The couple farmed near Moravia, and in the early 1950s moved to Grinnell. While living here, Mr. Glasgow worked as a farmhand and for the Chief Alfa Co. He also worked as a custodian at Grinnell Middle School.

Surviving are his wife; one daughter, Verla Glasgow of Grinnell; one grandson; a sister, Nancy Hawk of Centerville; and three brothers, LeRoy of Belleview, Fla., Howard of Kearns, Utah, and Eugene of LaVerkin, Utah.

He was preceded in death by his parents and four brothers, Ansel, Harvey, Dee and John.
