

Funeral Services Are Held For Mrs. Agnes Godfrey

Agnes Christie was born in Manchester, England, May 1, 1855. She was united in marriage with Thomas Godfrey in 1873 and to this union ten children were born, her husband and four of the children preceding her in death. Williams of Bethel, Mrs. James Iarsden and Tom Godfrey of Grinnell, Mrs. John Kinnaird of Gilman, Fred Godfrey, Toronto, Canada, and Mrs. A. E. Heacock, Baskaloosa, all her children.
