## Friday Funeral Services Set For Charity Goering

Mrs. Charity Ellen Goering, 87, widow of Alfred Herman Goering, passed away at a local nursing home Wednesday. She had been in failing health.

She was the daughter of Fred-eric and Margaret Robison Dose, born February 22, 1877, in Sheridan Township of Poweshiek county. Following her early education in the local rural schools, she later was united in marriage with Alfred Herman Goering on December 20th, 1916, at Des Moines.

To this union was born one daughter in 1918, Margaret, who passed away in 1924.

Mrs. Goering was also preceded in death by her husband, Alfred, on January 25, 1953, and a niece, Mrs. Walter Henke in April of this year.

Survivors include her three nieces, Mrs. Carsten Frank of Davenport, Mrs. M. B. Shuger and Mrs. Harry Bloehs, both of Wilton Junction. A niece of her husband, Mrs. Carl Frick of Stockton, Iowa, also survives.

Mrs. Goering had attended the Sheridan Methodist Church when she lived in this area. Following her marriage she and her husband farmed near Walcott, Iowa, later moving back to Grinnell to make their home.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m., Friday, at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Ralph Beebe of the Mayflower Home, officiating.
