Richard Golden Dies in Nebraska

A former Grinnell resident, Richard P. (Dick) Golden, 56, died Dec. 11 at his home at 2719½ 19th St. in Columbus, Neb.

He was a former directory salesman for General Telephone Co. here.

Mr. Golden was the son of John P. and Mary Morrow Golden and was born at O'Neill, Neb. On Oct. 31, 1941, he married Margaret Van Scoy in Omaha.

Surviving are his wife; three children—Richard Patrick II of Iowa City; Martina, a student at Kearney State College; and Robert; one grandson; his mother, two brothers and one sister.

He was preceded in death by his father, a brother and an infant son.
