Dorothy Reimer Goodwin, 90, of Tacoma, Wash., a native of Kellogg, died Sunday, Dec. 30, in Tacoma.

A celebration of her life is set for 1:30 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 19, in Lillian Pratt Parlor at Franke Tobey Jones Retirement Estates, 5340 N. Bristol, Tacoma. A graveside service will be held at a later date at Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg.

She was the daughter of George and Adah Irish Reimer and was born Dec. 11, 1911, in Kellogg. She attended Kellogg schools and was a 1929 graduate of Kellogg High School.

After graduating from Iowa State Teachers College, now the University of Northern Iowa, she taught sixth grade in Kellogg and in Brooklyn. She also taught for a few years in Japan.

She was married to George W. Goodwin in the fall of 1941. During his Army career they lived in California, Japan, Germany and Washington. Mrs. Goodwin had been a resident of Tacoma for almost 50 years.
