## Conduct Services Wednesday For Albert Graff, 61

Services were held Wednesday afternoon from James-Schalinske Funeral Home for Albert W. Graff, 61, who died Monday at a local hospital.

Officiating was the Rev. Laverne Streich, pastor of St. John's Lutheran church. Vocal music was provided by Mr. and Mrs. Russell Sams, accompanied by Mrs. Willard Heffner at the organ. Serving on the flower committee were Mrs. Lester Graff and Mrs. Paul Fogel.

The son of Henry and Augusta Friederichs Graff, he was born on August 12, 1903, near Grinnell, and received his education in the rural schools of Sheridan and Chester townships.

He was united in marriage with Alma Luttmann on Nov. 3, 1926, at Kellogg. Following their marriage they farmed in the Sheridan and Chester communities. Eight years ago they moved to Grinnell and he was employed by the athletic department at Grinnell College.

He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, the Farm Bureau, and the Honor G club at the college.
