Former Resident Dies In Denver

A native of Searsboro and former Grinnell resident, Miss Ella Graham, 65, of Denver, Colo., died Tuesday at a nursing home in Denver following an extended illness.

Funeral services for Miss Graham were held March 4 at the Assembly of God Church in Grinnell with the Rev. Donald A. Rich officiating. Burial was in the Fejerds Cemetery at Lynnville.
