Graveside services will be held Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock at Hazelwood cemetery for the Rev. John J. G. Graham, 90, former minister at Gilman, who died at Eldorado, Kans. Friends may call at the James Funeral Home to pay their respects.

A retired Congregational minister, John Graham was born July 23, 1866, at Centerville, W. Va. His pastorates in Kansas were five years at Eldorado and 12 years in Wichita. He also served the Congregational church in Nebraska, Iowa and Illinois. He was formerly a Presbyterian minister at Grand Island, Nebr., and at Gilman.

He was ordained 62 years on Aug. 6, and was a graduate of the Otterbeen university at Westerville, Ohio, and the Chicago Theological seminary in 1894.

He was married to Anna F. Stanley, Aug. 30, 1893, at Vinton, Ia. She died May 13, 1955. One son preceded him in death.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Esther Kassebaum of Eldorado and Mildred Leaper of Wichita; a son, Stanley, of Detroit; five grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
