Loren Graves, 14, Dies Suddenly At Camp Saturday

Loren Dwayne Graves, 14, son of Mr. and Mrs. Francis Graves of Grinnell, died suddenly of heart failure Saturday afternoon while at summer camp near Cedar Falls. He had been a heart patient for some time.

Funeral services are to be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday from the Northside Friends church with the pastor, the Rev. Kenneth Headland, officiating, assisted by the Rev. Kenneth Pohlenz, pastor of the First Friends church. Friends may call at the Smith Funeral Home.

Vocal music at the services will be provided by Robert Butler, accompanied by Mrs. Lotus Willison. Pallbearers will be John Lindsay, Bill Sears, Roger Mouchka, Tom Buck, Paul Rose and Glen Speas. Interment will be in Hazelwood cemetery.

Born Sept. 10th, 1948, at Marshalltown, he was the son of Francis and Arnola Buffett Graves. When he was six years old, the family moved to Grinnell, later moving to Newburg and then returning to Grinnell. He had been attending the local schools and would have been a sophomore at Grinnell high school this fall, with the class of 1966.

Survivors include his parents; one sister, Nola Francene; and one brother, Dale Garten, all of the family home. He was preceded in death by his grandparents.
