Robert Greenberg, 53, of 1126 Elm St., Grinnell, died of an aneurysm Saturday, Nov. 11, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

The son of Joseph and Molly Sarah Levy Greenberg, he was born Aug. 13, 1942, in New York City. He was raised in Manhattan and graduated from high school there. He received a B.A. degree in literature from Pratt University in New York. Mr. Greenberg served with the U.S. Army during the Vietnam conflict and was discharged in 1968. He lived in New York until 1973 when he moved to Houston, Texas.
