

## Mary A. Gregson Called By Death

Mary A. Reynolds was born Dec. 31, 1846 and died at her home in Montezuma, March 27, 1927, at the age of 80 years, 2 months and 24 days.

She was the second child of Alfred and Marion Reynolds of a family of 12 children.

On Dec. 31, 1864 she was married to James D. Gregson and to this union three children were born, all of whom have preceded her. George D. died October 21, 1868, Maggie A. March 5, 1900. Her husband died July 5, 1907 and Vest M. died Oct. 1917.

She leaves to mourn her loss three sisters and one brother, 2 grandchildren and many other relatives and friends.
