Willard C. Gullett, 75, of Rt. 1, Kellogg, died of cancer Sunday, April 19, at his rural home.

Funeral services were conducted April 21 at Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in Newton, with burial in Newton Memorial Park Cemetery.
