Mr. Guthrie services held

Howard D. Guthrie, 95, of Newton formerly of Kellogg, died Thursday, Aug. 1, at Skiff Memorial Hospital in Newton.

Funeral services were conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Reese Chapel in Newton, with the Rev. Trevor Davis-Hajek of the Kellogg United Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in Newton Union Cemetery.
