

## Mrs. Katherine Bray Haines Dies Suddenly In Des Moines

Mrs. Katherine Bray Haines died suddenly Saturday evening of a heart ailment in Des Moines.

She was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Henry M. Bray and sister of the late Mrs. Milton W. Swisher.

Katherine Bray was born in Grinnell December 15, 1875. She was graduated from Grinnell high school and Grinnell Academy.

The possessor of a beautiful soprano voice she studied at the Chicago conservatory and then went abroad to study voice in Paris.

She was married in June, 1905, to Robert M. Haines. For many years she was a member of the music faculty of Drake University and choir director at St. Johns Lutheran church.

She was a member of the Fortnightly Music club and Mu Phi Epsilon Music sorority.

She is survived by one son, Robert A. Haines of Tokyo, Japan, and two grandsons, a niece, Virginia Swisher Davidson of Grinnell and two nephews, Haworth S. Bray and Henry M. Bray of Arcadia, Calif.

Services will be held at Dunn's funeral home in Des Moines Tuesday afternoon at 3:00. The Reverend Frederick W. Wiertz of St. Johns Lutheran church will be in charge. The remains will be cremated and interred in the Bray family lot in Hazelwood cemetery at a later date.
