

Funeral Services Conducted For Mrs. F. M. Hale

Funeral services were held July 11, for Mrs. F. M. Hale, 1331 Spring street, who died Friday, July 8th, at the hospital. She was 83 years old and had been in ill health for the past three years.

The Rev. Leland W. Mann, minister of the First Congregational Church of Grinnell, officiated at the services. Burial was in an Ottumwa cemetery.

The daughter of Dr. J. C. Hinsey and Louisa Lentner Hinsey, she was born and raised in Ottumwa. In 1895 she was married to Frank Meade Hale and they continued to live in Ottumwa for the next ten years.
