Funeral services for Clarke Hall, 73, of Rt. 1, Brooklyn, were held at 11 a.m., Monday, Dec. 5, in the Nevenhoven Funeral Home, Brooklyn. Mr. Hall died Friday, Dec. 2, 1983, in the Brookhaven Nursing Home, Brooklyn.

Clarke Johnston Hall, son of Elza R. Hall and Margaret Johnston Hall, was born on a farm south of Brooklyn in Poweshiek County on Dec. 5, 1909. He graduated from the Brooklyn Hig School in 1928.

Mr. Hall was united in marriage to Suzanne Fauver on June 15, 1933, in Brooklyn. He farmed south of Brooklyn and in later years assisted his wife in the operation of the Brooklyn Theater.

Mr. Hall was a member of the First United Presbyterian Church and Corinthian Lodge No. 174 AF and AM. He was a Past Master and District Lecturer of Corinthian Lodge No. 174.

Survivors include his wife, Suzanne; two sons and their wives, Clarke Jr. and Patricia of MoundsView, Minn., and Roger and Joan of Malcom; one daughter, Mrs. Mary Hartnell of Normal, Ill.; six grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one grandchild.
