George Hall Dies Of Heart Attack

George Hall, 77, a Brooklyn resident all of his life, died suddenly at his home last Thursday following a heart attack.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday afternoon at two o'clock at Bramer's funeral home in charge of the Rev. G. H. Hulsebus, pastor of First Presbyterian church. Organist was Mrs. Ed Bartachek. Burial was in I.O.O.F. cemetery with Ed Graham, Harry Busch, Raymond Dale, Lester Wheeler, W. H. Amsbury and W. P. Newman serving as pallbearers.

George William Hall, son of William N. Hall and Alfretta Murdock Hall, was born July 24, 1881, in Brooklyn and died Dec. 4, 1958. He attended the Brooklyn schools and was employed by the Rock Island railroad until his retirement a number of years ago.

He was married Sept. 11, 1911, to Phoebe Pierce who preceded him in death in 1953. He was baptised in the former United Brethren church of South Brooklyn.

Survivors include his sister, Mrs. Lottie Hidlebaugh of Brooklyn, and a foster sister, Mrs. Lucy Wood of Marshalltown.
