Inez Hall, 71, formerly of Grinnell, died Monday, Dec. 25, in Los Angeles, Calif.

The daughter of Marion F. and Mary J. Otto Hall, she was born Jan. 14, 1901, in Brooklyn. She attended the Brooklyn public schools and was graduated from Brooklyn High School with the class of 1918. She taught rural school in Poweshiek County before moving to Grinnell in 1928. She had been associated with the former Community Hospital and had held several positions in the 37 years she worked there. On Feb. 18, 1972, she moved to Los Angeles to be near her son.

She was a member of the First Friends Church of Grinnell, as well as the missionary society of the church.

Survivors include her son and daughter-in-law, Austin and Edna Hall of Los Angeles; two grandchildren, Michael Hall of Los Angeles and Kathy Patton of Fairfield, Calif.; a great-granddaughter, Patty Patton of Fairfield; a sister-in-law, Mrs. Walter Hall of Grinnell; a nephew, Robert F. Hall of Knoxville; and several cousins. She was preceded in death by her parents; her brother, Walter Hall, who died in 1968; an infant sister; and a nephew, Maynard Hall, who died in infancy.
