## Conduct Rites Friday For Kellogg Resident

Fred Hammer of Kellogg, 71-year-old lifetime resident of Jasper county died suddenly Wednesday at a Newton hospital.

Funeral services will be held Friday, March 20th at Newton with the Rev. Morris Hay of Kellogg officiating. Interment will be in Center Friends cemetery near Newton.

Son of Curtis and Donna McBee Hammer, he was born in Jasper county on March 26th, 1887. He was educated in Jasper county schools and was a blacksmith by trade.

On June 26th, 1941, he was married to Lillian Lemke at Princeton, Mo. His wife survives.

Also surviving are five brothers, Glenn and Jay of Newton, Ira of Reasnor, and Edward and Clarence of Kellogg; and two sisters, Maude Hammer of Newton and Mrs. Rex Tratchel of Killduff.
