George R. Hargrave, 65, of 525 Tenth Ave. died of an apparent heart attack Monday evening, May 25, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Army Infantry for three years.

On Aug. 1, 1937, he was married to Helen Margaret Chacey in Grinnell. For 15 years he represented F. Brody and Son, Inc., of Des Moines, a clothing firm. In recent years he had traveled for Newton Manufacturing Co.
