Funeral services for Mrs. C. H. Harner, who died Monday, were held on Wednesday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock from the Church of Christ. The Rev. N. W. Underwood, pastor, had charge of the service. Burial was in the Montezuma cemetery.

Sarah Ida Christina Shook, daughter of John and Rozella Shook, was born November 21, 1870, near Montezuma, Iowa, and was called from this life September 17, 1934, at the age of 63 years, nine months and 26 days. She had lived her life in and near Montezuma, with the exception of one year in South Dakota, and one year in Nebraska.

On March 18, 1889, she was united in marriage to Charles Hess Harner, who preceded her to that Great Beyond October 21, 1901. To their union were born four children: Marion of New Sharon, Bertha Rempp of Montezuma, Ida Bryan of Montezuma, and Katie Good of New Sharon, who mourn the passing of their beloved mother. Sharing with them in their grief are seven grandchildren; one sister, Stella Farmer, of Grinnell; two half-sisters, Nina Williams of New Sharon and Vina Miller of Montezuma; her step-mother, Mrs. Julia Shook of Montezuma; and other relatives and a host of friends.
