Jennie See Harper

Jennie See, daughter of Jonathan and Mary Ellen See, was born April 12, 1876 in Maxwell, Iowa. Hi R 7-15-54

She passed away July 8, 1954 at the home of her daughter, Velma, in Minneapolis, Minn. at the age of 78.
