## Miss Hartman memorial set

Marv Jane Hartman, 86, of the Mayflower Home died Saturday morning, Aug. 10, at the Mayflower Home Health Care Center.

Following cremation, a memorial service will be conducted at 10:30 a.m. Friday, Aug. 23, in Denison Chapel of the Mayflower Home. A memorial has been established, and contributions may be directed to the Smith Funeral Home in Grinnell.

The daughter of the Rev. Robert C. and Ada May Longstreet Hartman, she was born Oct. 18, 1898, in Pleasant, Ind. She graduated from Rockport, Ind., High School in 1915 and attended Maryville College in Maryville, Tenn., for two years, later graduating from the University of Indiana. She was elected to Phi Beta Kappa and subsequently earned a master's degree from Columbia Teachers College in New York City.

A mathematics instructor, she had taught at Advance and Anderson, Ind., for nine years, then joined the faculty at Oak Park High School, Oak Park, Ill., a position she held for 31 years. She was a member of the First United Church of Oak Park.

Miss Hartman retired from teaching in 1960 and came to the Mayflower Home in 1975. While in Grinnell she was a member of the United Church of Christ-Congregational.

There are no immediate survivors.
