

Elisha Hartsock Passes Away 1933 In Lynnville

Elisha B. Hartsock, son of John and Margaret Hartsock, was born in Jefferson Co., Ind., Apr. 12, 1858 and grew to manhood in Indiana. He was united in marriage to Lizzie Earhart. To this union was born one son, John W. Hartsock.

He passed away Nov. 9, 1935, about 8:30 p. m., after an illness of three weeks, at the home of his only child, where he has made his home the past 23 years. He died at the age of 75 years, six months and 27 days.
