

# Miss Beulah Hatcher Died This Morning

Head of Commercial  
Dept. at High School  
Over Quarter of Century

Miss Beulah Hatcher, for over a quarter century a member of the faculty of Grinnell high school as head of the Commercial department, died at 6 o'clock this morning in the home of her sister, Mrs. E. E. Broell in Waterloo, after a lingering illness.

Miss Hatcher was forced by continued ill health to give up her teaching duties the first week in November.

The body has been taken to Mechanicsville, Miss Hatcher's former home, for funeral services and burial. Funeral arrangements are incomplete at this time.

Miss Hatcher taught typing, stenography and business English during her long service on the high school faculty. She was a competent teacher who commanded the respect and esteem of her students and her service in Grinnell was fruitful and effective.
