Claire Mott Haworth, 84, of rural Ewart and recently of Friendship Manor, died of a combined stroke and heart attack Saturday, Nov. 2, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday at the Watts Funeral Home in Montezuma, with the Rev. Glenn Hulsebus of the Ewart Presbyterian Church officiating. Burial was in Pleasant Township Cemetery, Ewart.
