June Irene Hay, 59, formerly of Grinnell, died Thursday, April 3, at Skiff Memorial Hospital in Newton.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at the Wallace-Pence Funeral Home, with the Revs. Nolan Kelsey of the Hickory Grove Church and Oscar Shepherd of the Foursquare Church officiating. Burial was in Newton Memorial Park Cemetery.
